Course Description

Life Science is a science course that covers the study of living things while focusing on the Minnesota State Standards in Science. Life Science focuses on the study of life by examining the following 4 concepts of science:

1. Structure and Function of Living Things
2. Interdependence Among Living Systems
3. Evolution in Living Systems
4. Human Interaction with Living Systems

Grading Policy:
