Nurse Notes

Is it the Influenza or just a Common Cold?

How do you know if you have the flu or a common cold? Many experts say, "Take your temp." Flu symptoms often mimic cold symptoms with nasal congestion, cough, body aches, and tiredness. But a fever over 101 degrees rarely accompanies a common cold.

A cold is a milder respiratory illness than the flu. While cold symptoms can make you feel bad for a few days, flu symptoms can make you feel quite ill for weeks. Cold symptoms usually begin with a sore throat, which usually goes away after a day or two. Nasal symptoms, runny nose, and congestion follow, along with a cough by the 4th and 5th days. Fever is uncommon in adults, but a slight fever is possible, especially in children. Flu symptoms are more severe than cold symptoms and come on quickly. Symptoms of flu include sore throat, fever, headache, muscle aches and soreness, congestion and cough.
