Listed below are the screenings that are routinely done at Adrian Public Schools:

Hearing: Adequate hearing is a key part of your students learning process. Your child's hearing will be screened annually while they are in elementary school – Kindergarten-5th grade. Preschoolers will also have their hearing screened at Preschool Screening. You or your child's teacher may also request this service. A referral to your health care provider is mailed to you if a concern is suspected.

Vision: Good eyesight is essential to good learning. Your child's vision will be screened annually while they are in elementary school: Kindergarten-5th grade. Preschoolers will also be screened at Preschool Screening. These screenings can also be done at your request or at the request of your child's teacher. If a potential concern is discovered, a referral is mailed to the parent.

Scoliosis: Routine examinations for scoliosis will be done for both boys and girls in 4th and 5th grade. If a potential concern is discovered, a referral is mailed to the parent.

*****These screenings are part of a preventative health measure. Please remember that these are just screenings and do not determine a diagnosis. If a concern is discovered, the parent will be notified. These screenings should not replace your student's yearly well-child exams or routine eye exams. These exams can be done for any student throughout the year upon request.*
