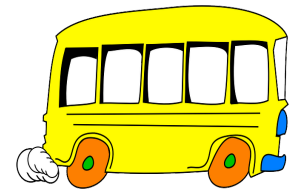

Bus Reminders:

 - Parent signature and phone number
- Bus notes must be brought in to the office before school and the student will be given a bus pass for that day.
- If you are calling the school with a change to your child's regular form of transportation, **please do so by 2 P.M.**, so we can make sure the appropriate people can be notified.
- Any preschool student who is riding the bus needs to have a Bus Buddy who gets on and off at the same stop as the preschooler. If a preschooler does not have a Bus Buddy, they will not be allowed to ride the bus that day.

School Safety Updates

Keeping our students and staff safe at school is something we take very seriously. Each year schools in Minnesota are responsible for conducting several safety drills, including five fire drills, five lockdown drills, and one severe weather/tornado drill. Over the past few years there has been a lot of research on school safety due to the number of school violence situations that have taken place. Building security is one of the first things schools look at, and the school buildings in Adrian are now locked for most of the day. In order to best prepare our students and staff for potential dangerous situations, such as an active shooter situation, we have brought ALICE training to our schools. In August, all staff participated in an initial ALICE training, where we learned about different ways to respond to a threat. We were fortunate to have Ryan Kruger, a Nobles County Sheriff Deputy, provide this training. **ALICE stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Confront, and Evacuate.** Over the course of this school year, we will be taking time to talk to our students and staff about the ALICE approach, with a focus on changing the way we deal with potential threats that offer our students and staff the best opportunities to be safe in a potentially dangerous situation.
