All summer recreation activities include a minimal fee for accident insurance that has been purchased by the school district. The policy covers all participants in the Summer Recreation Program. When an injury covered by this policy results in treatment by a licensed physician within 30 days from the date of injury, the company will pay the usual and customary charges incurred for necessary services and supplies for charges actually incurred within one year from date of injury, up to a maximum of \$5,000 per injury. This plan covers only medical expenses that are not payable by any other valid coverage. Therefore, you must first file a claim with your own family coverage.

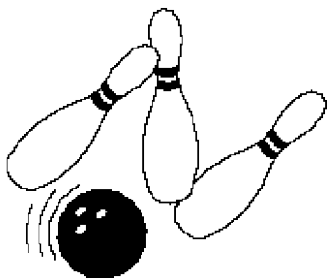
